



#### Report On International Women's Day 2024

On this occasion of International Women's Day on 08th March, 2024 prevention of Internal Complaint committee and Department of Zoology, Matoshri Nanibai Gharphalkar Science College has organized an guest lectures on the theme "Inspire Inclusion" the program was conducted on 13/3/2024 at 02.00 Pm, Chief Guest for the program was Dr. Smita B. Patil Assistant Professor, Department of Zoology, Matoshri Nanibai Gharphalkar Science college, Babhulgaon and Guest of honour was Dr. Bhavana S. Pillai Assistant Professor, Department of Zoology, Matoshri Nanibai Gharphalkar Science college, Babhulgaon.

The first speaker (Chief Guest) Dr. Smita B. Patil highlighted the need to recognize the increased number of women in the corporate and management sector, they are mostly located as support staff. There are considerably fewer women executives at the higher levels of decision making. Highlighted the contribution of the great women leaders such as Savitri bai Phule and Dr. Baba saheb Ambedkar they work for wellfair of the society. Further she also highlighted how the pandemic has also a gendered effect, with women at different levels facing job and income loss. She also referred to how institutions such as family and educational spaces can play a supportive role in furthering women's fight for equality and power. She concluded by emphasizing on the need for women to focus on self- care, self-acceptance and be confident of their decisions and situation is considerable has changed now from the earlier time period.

Dr. Bhavana S. Pillai started her talk by highlighting the importance of inclusive policies and stated that only by including its women's citizens can any nation prosper. She also highlighted the role of education in ensuring that women's access to resources, assets and positions of authority is guaranteed. Drawing from her own life experiences, she emphasized the role of supportive networks such as family, friends, peers and colleagues who would play an important role in supporting the life choices made by women. Dr. Bhavana S. Pillai also shared some insights with regards to violence against women, by drawing attention to cases of foeticide, child marriage and human trafficking. By sharing two inspiring stories of strong women Sudha Murthi co-founder of Infosis who have fought the violence experienced by old ritual of devdasi at her village she was successful in eradicating devdasi ritual from the village and saved 3000 womens, and then these womens created a new path for themselves, she emphasized the strength and perseverance that women.

The chairperson Dr. P. N. Mulkalwar principal, Matoshri Nanibai Gharphalkar Science College shared his view on the topic, need to look back to our past to draw inspiration from some strong women, who have carved for themselves a special role in the political economic field. Drawing upon the experiences of women rulers, the speaker highlighted how women over the years have negotiated for power. He also highlighted that to access and control power, these women rulers have used various strategies at their disposal; thereby highlighting how the fight for power is always contested and needs to be fought for. Also drew our attention to the need to carefully look for sources of knowledge.

All the speakers shared their personal experiences with science as a profession and science as a laboratory and experimental process. They highlighted the importance of maintaining personal and professional work balance. One of the important messages that emerged out of the discussion is the way women scientists evolve the coping mechanism to excel in scientific research and practice. It was one of the best panel discussions that inspired a number of the participants.


